## 1945 DRAFT

Held April 8, 1945

Although the Boston and Brooklyn franchises merged for the 1945 season, at the time of the draft they still were independent franchises, and each selected separately. Neither gave up its rights to any players while the merger was in effect. Pittsburgh and the Chicago Cardinals which had been merged in 1944, alternately selected first, second, and third (with Brooklyn) for their last-place finish the previous season.

In 1944, the league had passed a special one-year rule allowing a handful of players who still had college eligibility to play one year in the NFL and then to be returned to the preferred negotiations list. In 1945. This rule primarily was aimed at those players who were unable to play collegiately because their programs had dropped football, but also included some who had left school but then had been ineligible to serve in the Armed Forces. In 1945, three such players were selected after a year in the NFL: Paul Duhart (Pittsburgh, second round), Russ Lowther (Detroit, sixth round), and John Morelli (Boston, twenty-eighth round). One other player -- John Itzel (Pittsburgh, seventeenth round) -- was granted special permission to be selected and to play in 1945, returning to the preferred negotiations list in 1946.
